DAY 1 Beijing Arrival (PEK or PKX)

Welcome to Beijing! Upon arrival at Beijing Airport, you will be escorted directly to your hotel to rest after your journey.

Arrival day airport transfer: For flights arriving between 10:00 AM and 8:00 PM, we will arrange three free airport pick-ups depending on the actual situation. For flights arriving outside of these times, additional pick-up fees \$50/P will apply.

DAY 2 Beijing – Tiananmen Square

After breakfast, set out with your guide to discover Beijing's iconic imperial treasures. Visit the immense **Tiananmen Square** and explore its sacred grounds. Following the tour, enjoy free time to explore the city at your leisure, or opt for an enhanced experience with one of our optional excursions.

Optional tour: Forbidden City Tour (\$80.00/pp)

Step into the world-famous Forbidden City, the vast complex that served as the imperial palace for centuries during the Ming and Qing dynasties.

Optional tour: Hutong Life Tour (\$40.00/pp)

Immerse yourself in the charm of old Beijing on our Hutong Life Tour. Stroll through narrow lanes lined with traditional courtyard houses. This intimate experience offers a unique glimpse into the city's vibrant history and hidden corners. You'll be invited to step into a local Beijing home for an authentic glimpse of daily life.

DAY 3 Jade Carving Workshop and the Great Wall

Today holds a true bucket-list destination: the Great Wall of China. Recognized as one of the Seven Wonders of the World and a UNESCO treasure. Your visit focuses on the **Great Wall at Juyongguan section**, one of its three great passes. On the way, you'll stop at one of China's premier **Jade Exhibitions** to discover the story behind this celebrated stone. Once back in Beijing, the evening is yours to relax or enhance your journey with an optional activity.

Optional tour: Summer Palace with meal (\$90.00/pp)

The Summer Palace is a UNESCO-listed masterpiece of Chinese landscape garden design. Originally an imperial retreat, it perfectly harmonizes breathtaking architecture with natural scenery. Your visit will be complemented by an exquisite Chinese meal.

DAY 4 Beijing to Suzhou by high-speed train

Your day begins after breakfast with a visit to a **Traditional Chinese Health Center** for an introduction to the world of traditional Chinese medicine. Following this, you will explore the **Temple of Heaven**, Beijing's most sacred imperial temple and a UNESCO-listed masterpiece of architecture and landscape design.

In the late afternoon, you will experience China's world-class high-speed rail network firsthand. Upon arrival Suzhou, a local guide will assist you to your hotel.

Please note that your bullet train may be scheduled to arrive at Wuxi East Station. Please adhere precisely to the details on your train ticket, which will be provided by your Beijing guide.

DAY 5 Suzhou to Wuxi by coach

Suzhou is home to more UNESCO World Heritage-listed gardens than any city on earth. Begin your exploration at the **Lingering Garden**, a jewel in Suzhou's crown of classical gardens. Next, immerse yourself in the art of silk at the Suzhou **Silk Factory**, considered the largest in China, where you'll learn about the intricate journey from cocoon to luxurious fabric. Concluding with an optional canal cruise, you'll then embark on a picturesque one-hour drive to Wuxi.

Optional tour: Suzhou Grand Canal Cruise(\$60/pp)

Step aboard a traditional boat and slip into the serene, watery heart of old Suzhou. The canal cruise along the historic Shan Tang Street offers a peaceful escape and a unique perspective on a city celebrated for its canals. The journey shows you the "Venice of the East" not as a museum, but as a living, breathing community.

DAY 6 Wuxi to Hangzhou by coach

This morning begins with a visit to **Lihu Lake**, a scenic inlet of the larger Taihu Lake. Renowned for its beautiful parkland and unique attractions, the lake also holds a special place in Chinese culture. Afterwards, you will visit a **Freshwater Pearl Farm** by Taihu Lake, where generations have been cultivating pearls in its waters, and their products are sold worldwide.

This afternoon we continue on to Hangzhou, a city Marco Polo famously declared the world's most beautiful. After we arrive, you'll have a free evening to explore at your own pace — perhaps relax after the journey, or opt for an evening excursion to enjoy a local performance.

Optional tour: Romantic Show of Song-Cheng(\$105/pp)

The **"Romantic Show of Song Cheng"** is a must-see cultural icon in Hangzhou. This grand-scale theatrical experience combines powerful performances with impressive sound and light designed to narrate the epic story of the city. It transports you through history: from the bravery of the Yue Army, culminating in beloved legends like "The Butterfly Lovers".

DAY 7 Hangzhou to Shanghai by coach

Known as "Paradise on Earth," Hangzhou's beauty has been celebrated through the ages. You'll then venture into the rolling hillsides to taste the world-renowned Dragon Well Tea, a premium green tea cherished for its healthful antioxidants and cultural significance in a **Tea Plantation**.

In the afternoon, you depart for the bustling metropolis of Shanghai. To cap off the day, consider the optional Huangpu River cruise, a spectacular way to witness the city's dazzling neon skyline come to life at night.

Optional tour: Huangpu River Cruise(\$80/pp)

Shanghai is a city that captivates both day and night. A night cruise offers a front-row seat to its sparkling spectacle. The historic Bund glows under shimmering lights, presenting a grand gallery of world architecture against the city skyline. To the east, the futuristic towers of Lujiazui dazzle with a vibrant palette of dreamlike colors, creating an unforgettable panorama.

Venture into the heart of Shanghai's financial prowess at Lujiazui, where you'll encounter the **Majestic Jinmao Tower**. Soaring 420.5 meters over 88 floors, its name evokes "golden prosperity." The building epitomizes a harmonious fusion of timeless Chinese design principles with contemporary global engineering. Next, experience a different side of the city at **Xintiandi**, this celebrated area retains the charm of Shanghai's signature **"Shikumen" architecture**, now revitalized into a stylish cultural and leisure quarter that draws a global audience.

Optional tour: Shanghai Chinese Acrobatic Show(\$105.00/pp)

ERA is a grand-scale multimedia spectacle, a breathtaking feat of acrobatics and technology unique in China. It draws its power from the dynamic fusion of traditional artistry and modern innovation, much like the city of Shanghai itself — a place where history and the future are in constant, thrilling dialogue.

- 5.All guests must follow the published group itinerary. The local service provider reserves the right to cancel any onward travel arrangements for guests who deviate from the planned schedule. This requirement does not apply to optional tours.
- 6.If you choose not to join an optional tour, your guide will drop you at a designated location and tell you when and where to rejoin the group. If you prefer to return to the hotel or explore independently, your guide can help arrange a private transfer for you in advance, the cost of any private transfer will be your own expense.
- 7.Cancellation & Refund Policy: Cancellations made 16 or more days prior to the scheduled departure date are eligible for a refund with a handling fee\$100.00/pp reduced. No refunds will be granted for cancellations made within 16 days of departure.
